
PROTECTED INNOCENCE CHALLENGE STATE ACTION. NATIONAL CHANGE.

The Protected Innocence Challenge is a comprehensive study of state laws that address domestic minor sex trafficking. Each year, states receive a report card grading its laws and an analysis and recommendations report that identifies areas for improvement. This study serves as a blueprint for policy makers and advocates to target efforts to address key gaps in state law for the protection of children.
