ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW: Shared Hope International is a 501(c)3 nonprofit headquartered in Vancouver, Washington with an office in Arlington, Virginia. Shared Hope International works to combat sex slavery globally and restore the women and children who are victims of sexual slavery. Since 1998, Shared Hope International has partnered with local groups to bring about the critical intervention, rescue and restoration for victims of human trafficking. At the same time, Shared Hope International engages in research, domestic policy initiatives, legislative advocacy and public awareness campaigns across the United States.

<u>POSITION OVERVIEW:</u> A Shared Hope **Ambassador of Hope** raises awareness in their community about Shared Hope International's three-pronged effort to end sex trafficking: prevent, restore and bring justice.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- 1. Develops contacts to create a network to bring awareness. This includes (but is not limited to) civic groups, local community groups, government and city officials, schools, faith-based organizations, parent groups, social groups, etc.
- 2. Becomes thoroughly educated on and uses Shared Hope resources for all presentations and discussions.
- 3. Reports all activities by submitting an **Event Summary Form**.
- 4. Always collects attendee information at gatherings and submits the **Shared Hope International Event Sign-Up Sheet** to the Manager of Awareness/Ambassador Resources via email/mail.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Submit Ambassador of Hope application with references.
- 2. Pass Background Check ordered by Shared Hope International.
- 3. Once approved as an Ambassador of Hope, complete online training as assigned.
- 4. Cover the costs of the Ambassador of Hope resource kit with a suggested donation of \$89. The Ambassador of Hope resource kit includes Chosen Plus DVD kit, T-shirt, name badge and flash drive with electronic toolkit files.
- 5. Provide monthly feedback on activities.

<u>ABILITIES:</u> (Ambassadors of Hope must have a passion to end sexual trafficking and at least one of the following skills)

- 1. To conduct public presentations
- 2. To plan an event
- 3. To develop community relationships

4. To manage a community event booth
