- By law enforcement if the child is ill, injured, in immediate danger, or ran away

Placement:

- Release to parents, guardian or legal custodian
- Shelter or other care

Placement:

- Release to parents, guardian or legal custodian
- Shelter or other care
- Placement designated by the court

→ **Authority for Initial Custody:**

A child can be taken into custody:

- By law enforcement under laws of arrest, or if the child is in immediate danger

- Detention
- Shelter or other care
