2017 LEGISLATIVE PROGRESS REPORT

Every day, thousands of children are bought and sold for sex in the U.S. To help states to end and prevent these heinous crimes, Shared Hope International has established the Stop the inJuSTice: States Take Action Campaign.

The Stop the inJuSTice campaign advocates for state laws which both protect victims of juvenile sex trafficking and hold offenders accountable. For the past six years, Shared Hope has analyzed the laws of all fifty states and the District of Columbia, and issues an annual report card assessing the strength of those laws in combatting juvenile sex trafficking and protecting victims. While substantial progress has been made, over the past few years, critical gaps remain.

To close these gaps in state laws, Shared Hope International collaborates with concerned legislators, galvanizes public support, and utilizes state law research and targeted recommendations to advance statutory changes at the state level. The goal of the Stop the inJuSTice campaign is to see at least six states enact laws in six months that address these vital issues and gaps.

SINCE THE BEGINNING **OF THE YEAR:**

- 13 states and DC have enacted bills related to juvenile sex trafficking.
- **54 more bills** are pending in 24 states.
