FUNCTION:

The Creative Intern (CI) for the Growth Strategies Department of Shared hope International (SHI) is responsible for supporting the department by performing supportive creative duties that would include, but are not limited to, capturing/logging/tagging media assets, organizing/prioritizing projects, communicating with internal/external collaborators, graphic design, digital content production, asset procurement and other tasks as assigned or needed. The CI would also support other areas of SHI as required, attend various community events for the purpose of digital content capture, research and reporting.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- 1. Organizing/logging/tagging existing media assets in a server as well as in an application library setting in a sustainable/searchable system for future use.
- 2. Scrubbing current media projects and media storage to tag previously used media selections.
- 3. Implement and execute a rating system within already existing media assets for the purpose of future use.
- 4. Works closely with Creative Projects Coordinator assisting on existing and upcoming projects, as requested.
- 5. Collaborate on conceptualizing/pitching projects/ideas.
- 6. Assist in maintaining progress/benchmark updates on active projects and through weekly reporting.
- 7. Performs other tasks duties as assigned by Creative Projects Coordinator or the Director of Growth Strategies.
