FUNCTION:

The Full-time Vision and Call Program Internship with Shared Hope International is a 9 to 12 month position that holds a three-fold purpose: 1) to provide a transforming experience for young adults; 2) to increase the pool of talented emerging leaders entering into the anti-trafficking movement; and 3) to educate and empower a commitment to the development of young leaders on the part of Christian organizations. Under the direct care and leadership of the Director of Growth Strategies, the intern will integrate into the department and work alongside the program managers of Shared Hope's child sex trafficking awareness and faith initiatives. The intern will also complete various awareness-related projects, included a special project designed by the intern, will attend community outreach events, and carry out research, as needed.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

1. Provides support of the Ambassador of Hope and Defenders programs by:
 - a. Becoming an Ambassador of Hope, becoming fully integrated into the program by learning the role and skills of a trained Ambassador
 - b. Assist with providing love, stewardship and care to Ambassadors seeking technical, and training support, and resources
 - c. Processing emails and applications from Ambassador and Defender applicants
 - d. Maintains awareness@sharedhope.org email by responding via email to general inquiries from the public and Ambassadors
2. Works closely with the National Outreach Manager on developing, implementing and disseminating collateral and resources for Shared Hope's faith initiative, aiming to equip and empower people of faith to engage in the fight against child sex trafficking.
3. Works closely with the Community Engagement Manager on implementing community outreach, including research, attending events, attending Task Force meetings, and developing and implementing awareness collateral and resources.
4. Assist with coordinating the Winter Gratitude Campaign
5. Inputs and maintains data from activities into Salesforce (customer relations management system)
6. Completes special awareness project designed by the intern
7. Performs other projects or duties as assigned by supervisor

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Self-motivated and capable of working independently and on a deadline.

2. Full-time, 40 hours/week, 9 to 12-month time commitment.
3. Able to work on a team as a trustworthy member.
4. A positive and pleasant “can-do” attitude.
5. A passionate concern for women in crisis and the eradication of sexual slavery.
6. High School diploma minimum.
7. Excellent written and oral skills.
8. Proficient level of computer skills including Microsoft Word, Excel, and Outlook.
9. Strong organizational skills, attention to detail and critical thinking skills.
10. Ability to manage various projects simultaneously.

ABILITIES:

1. Ability to stand or sit for prolonged duration
2. Ability to perform repetitive finger, hand and arm movements
3. Ability to lift 25 lbs.
4. Talking/giving verbal instructions in close range and speaking over the phone
5. Able to perform simple math
6. Ability to utilize electronic equipment such as computer, 10-key, telephone, etc.
7. Ability to think critically and problem solve
