


Founder's Gala and 25th Anniversary Party

Dr. Charrita Ernewein Chair of the Board of Directors | Valrico, FL

Dr. Charrita Ernewein, PhD, DNP, APRN, FNP-C, SANE-A, FAANP, is an Assistant Professor of Nursing at The University of Tampa and works at the Crisis Center of Tampa Bay. With over 34 years of nursing experience, including 11 years as an APRN and 26 years as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner, she also serves as Community

Education Director for the Free Network. Her research focuses on healthcare providers' roles in supporting human trafficking survivors. Dr. Ernewein has delivered over 100 trainings on human trafficking to thousands globally and has published extensively on the topic. Passionate about advocacy, she aims to promote culturally sensitive, traumainformed care and integrate survivors' voices into training programs. Married to retired Air Force pilot Ken, she is a proud mother of four. Dr. Ernewein joined Shared Hope's Board of Directors in 2023 and was sworn in as the Chair of the Board of Directors today. Dr. Jason Curtis

Vice Chair of the Board of Directors | Portland, OR

Jason has nearly 30 years of experience in the church and nonprofit sectors, focusing on teaching, coaching, and leadership development. Linda Smith

Shared Hope Founder and President | Vancouver, WA

Our founder, Linda Smith, is a global leader in ending sex trafficking. She served as a WA state legislator from 1983-1993 and was later elected to Congress in 1994. While in Congress, Linda became aware of trafficking in Mumbai, India. In 1998, she left Congress to establish Shared Hope International, focusing on combatting child and youth

trafficking. Linda has authored key works on trafficking and testified before Congress. She resides in Washington, spearheading global efforts to combat child and youth trafficking.

Jennifer Cox Board of Directors | Eagle, ID

Jennifer Cox is the System Director for CommonSpirit Health's Physician Enterprise, Medical Safe Haven program. With over 25 years in healthcare, she has held roles as an Executive Director for a nonprofit clinic and a Health Educator, and served as a women's and community outreach minister. Jennifer co-developed the



Medical Safe Haven model in 2015, which trains physicians to provide trauma-informed care for human trafficking survivors and is now replicated in six clinics across California. She has presented on this model at many of our JuST Conferences with the American Academy of Family Practice! A lead developer for trauma-informed training, Jennifer has educated over 15,000 individuals nationwide. She has served on multiple nonprofit boards, led humanitarian efforts in Kosovo and Brazil, and holds degrees in Business Leadership and Communications. Jennifer is proud to have raised three children. Jennifer has served on Shared Hope's Board of Directors since May of 2023.





Bill Dunning Board of Directors | Olympia, WA

Bill Dunning brings over 30 years of business leadership to the Board. After earning a civil engineering degree from Old Dominion University, he co-founded a Seattle-based civil engineering firm in 1994, expanding it to 8 offices across 3 states. Bill has collaborated with NGOs in 18 countries, supporting community care programs,

church establishments, child welfare, and anti-exploitation efforts. He has worked with Shared Hope as a professional volunteer, traveling to our Homes of Hope in Fiji, Jamaica, and Nepal to help with construction and structural integrity of our various homes. Specializing in facility planning and mobilizing ministry and construction teams, he has served on both nonprofit and for-profit boards. Dr. Christine Harmon Immediate Past Chair | Burien, WA

Dr. Christine Harmon has had a long medical career, beginning as a Physician's Assistant in Pediatric/Adolescent Medicine, earning her MD from the University of Colorado, and completing a Family Medicine Residency at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.



She practiced Family and Urgent Care Medicine for over 30 years in Tacoma, WA, focusing on Pediatric/Adolescent Medicine, Women's Health, and Mental Health, and enjoyed mentoring young medical professionals. Currently a Medical Consultant to the Social Security Administration, she has also been involved with Shared Hope International since 2010, serving on the Board of Directors since 2015 and as Chair since 2018.
